

Directions to The Center for Educational Design and Communication (CEDC) From Airports (without a car)

From BWI Airport:

The most economical option from BWI is to travel via the Metro. There is a Metro Bus that picks up outside the baggage claim at BWI, and will take you to the **Greenbelt Metro Station** on the Green Line (Bus Fare-\$3.00). From there, take the Green Line towards Washington, transfer at the Fort Totten Metro Station. From Fort Totten, take the Red Line south towards Union Station. You will exit at your first stop, the Brookland/CUA Metro Stop. (Metro Fare \$1.85) From this point, you can either walk or take a bus as is detailed in the **From Metro directions**. If you feel that you will need a taxi to get to the Center, stay on the Red Line two stops further and exit at Union Station, where you will find a cab the most easily. Another transportation option is to take the blue **"Super Shuttle"** Van from BWI that will take you directly to the door. Arrangements for these can be made at the Super Shuttle kiosk in Baggage Claim, or by calling 1-800-BLUE-VAN. Monday-Friday you can also travel via the **MARC** train directly from BWI to Union Station. (Fare: \$5.00 <http://www.mtmaryland.com/services/marc>)

From Dulles Airport:

The most economical option from Dulles is to take the **Metrobus** to the DC Metro. The Metrobus picks up at Dulles every half hour and goes first to the Falls Church and then to the Rosslyn stops on the Blue and Orange Line. (Bus Fare \$3.00) From either stop take the Blue or Orange Line to Metro Center, then transfer to the Red Line. From there you can depart at Union Station and take a taxi, or come to the Brookland/CUA stop and walk. (Metro Fare \$1.35-See **From Metro directions** for both) At Dulles you also have the option of taking the **Washington Flyer bus service** (www.washfly.com) or the **Super Shuttle** service (www.supershuttle.com, 1-800-BLUE VAN).

By Taxi:

Tell the driver that you want to go to the corner of Varnum Street, Northeast, and the 800 block of Varnum St (an access road) which is located 2 blocks west of Providence Hospital, and is near Catholic University. Once you get to that corner tell the driver to take a left onto the 800 block of Varnum St. The Center is the last building on the right.
